Student council meets once a week to discuss events and collects input from the student body during "Meet your Student Council" events.

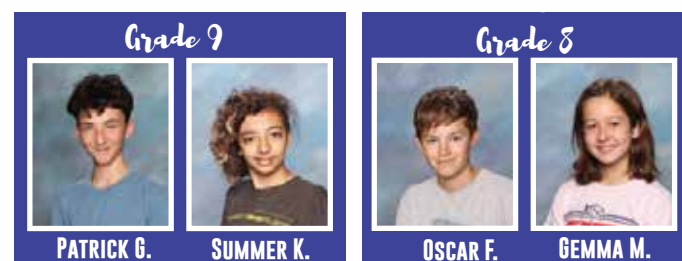
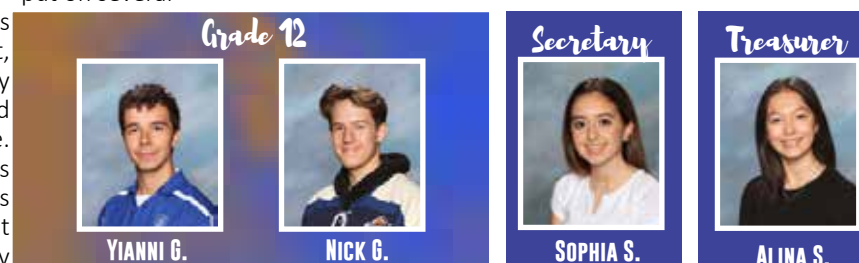

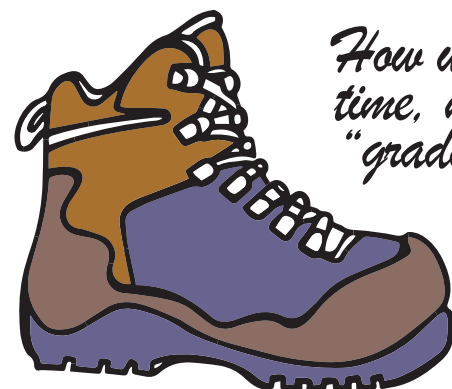
Wilderness whenever she gets the chance. Thank you Ladies, for all you have done for the many Kits students over the years, and we wish you all the best!
